



Quick Installation Guide

Refer to this guide for steps on how to connect your modem and use your WiFi network

Included Equipment



Power Adapter



Ethernet Cord



Phone Cord

Step 1: Connecting to the Internet

From the rear of your modem, plug the Phone Cord into the DSL WAN port. Then, plug the other end of the phone cord into a telephone jack.

From the back of your modem, plug the ethernet cord into any ETHERNET 1-4 port. Now, plug the other end of the ethernet cord into a working ethernet port on your computer.

Now, from the rear of your modem, connect the Power Adapter. Then, plug the Power Adapter into an external power source.

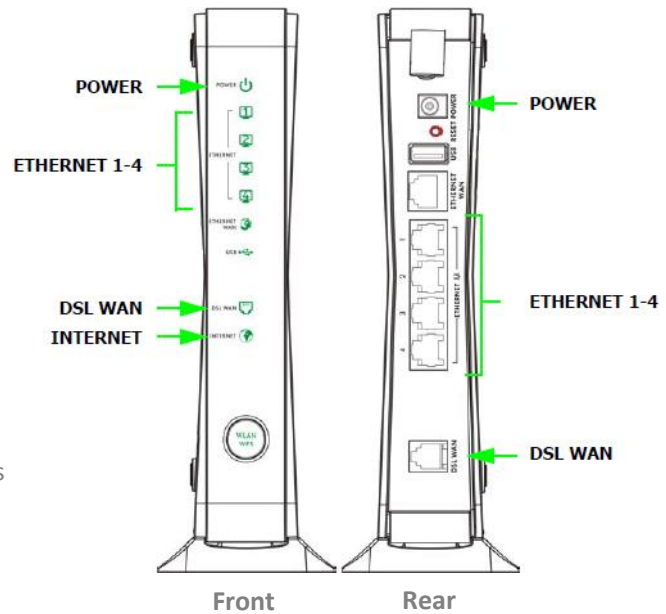
Within 2 minutes you should see the front panel light up as you begin to connect to the internet.

Check that the front panel of your modem is behaving as such:

POWER (solid green)

DSL WAN (solid green)

INTERNET (solid or blinking green)

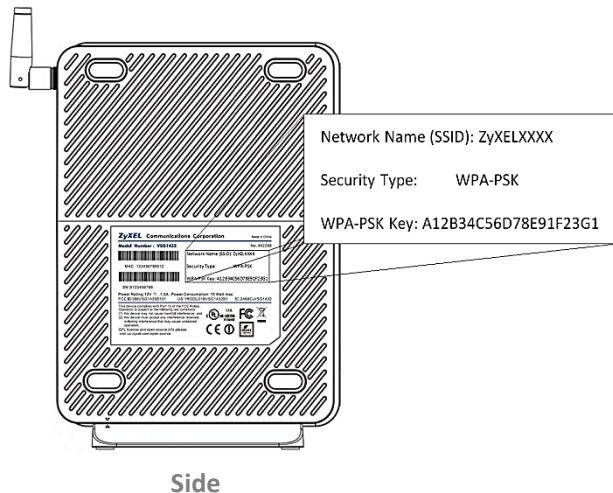


Step 2: Connecting Devices to your Wi-Fi Network

Note: Prior to connecting to your Wi-Fi network ensure that you have connected your modem's antenna

Step 1: In the Wi-Fi settings of your laptop, tablet, smartphone or other device, look for your modem's wireless network name (found on the side of the modem under "Network Name (SSID): ZyXELXXXX") and click or tap to connect to it.

Step 2: When prompted for the security key or password, enter your Wi-Fi Key (found on the side of the modem under "WPA-PSK Key: XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX") and select Connect to go online.
